






SALVADORAN MIGRATION

1 out of each 4 Salvadorans lives OVERSEAS.



ECONOMIC FIGURES


- Gross domestic product \$15,824 billion
- Total remittances for the same year totaled 2,548 billion:
 - 16% of such GDP
 - 133% of net in-bond assembly exports,
 - 86% of commercial gap
 - 655% foreign direct investment
 - 1.8% of total world remittances

DISTRIBUTION OF SALVADORAN MIGRATION 160,000 46,000 2,500,000 **3,200** 2.8 million Salvadorans live **OVERSEAS** (including second generations). 63,000 A quarter of the Salvadoran population VICEMINISTERIO 90% migrants are in the **United States.** 3,000 Geographical distribution in PARA LOS other destinations: Canada, Central America, Mexico, Australia, Italy, Sweden, en el exterior etc.

SALVADORAN MIGRATION

Impacts:

- Increase in the flow of family and group remittances.
- Growing relation of the Salvadoran community OVERSEAS and their place of origin, which causes numerous dynamic impacts
 - Changes in sociocultural patterns
 - Forms of civil society participation and decision-making processes
 - Local investment processes and growth in business and services
 - ♣ Relevance in mass media
- Establishing a community (society) OVERSEAS
 - Complex; diverse interests (heterogeneous)
 - Higher organizational levels
 - Higher participation in local politics
- Increase in relationships among communities OVERSEAS
 - Establishment of networks based on areas of interest
 - ♣ Agreements and joint projects
