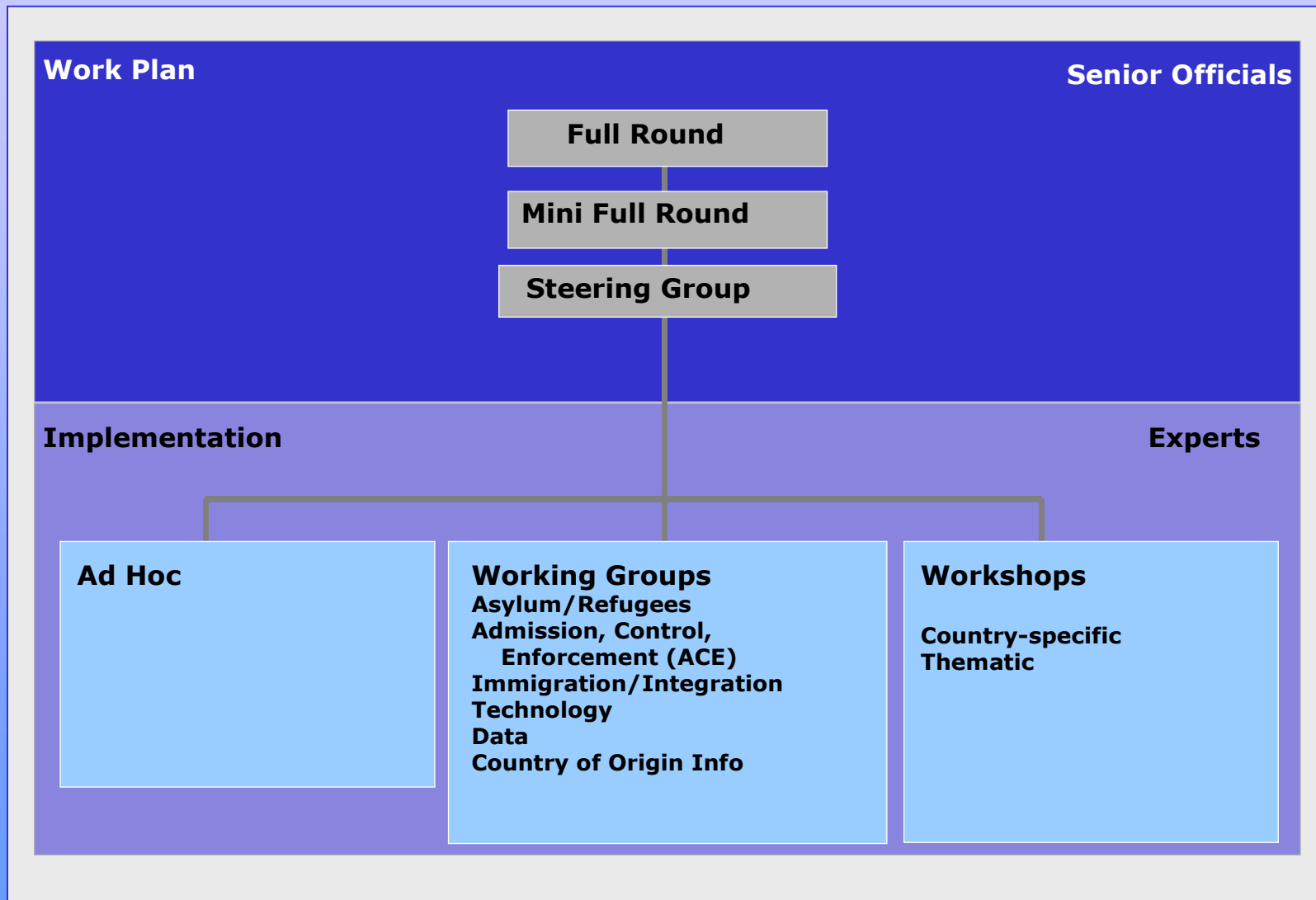

## Structure & Role of the Secretariat

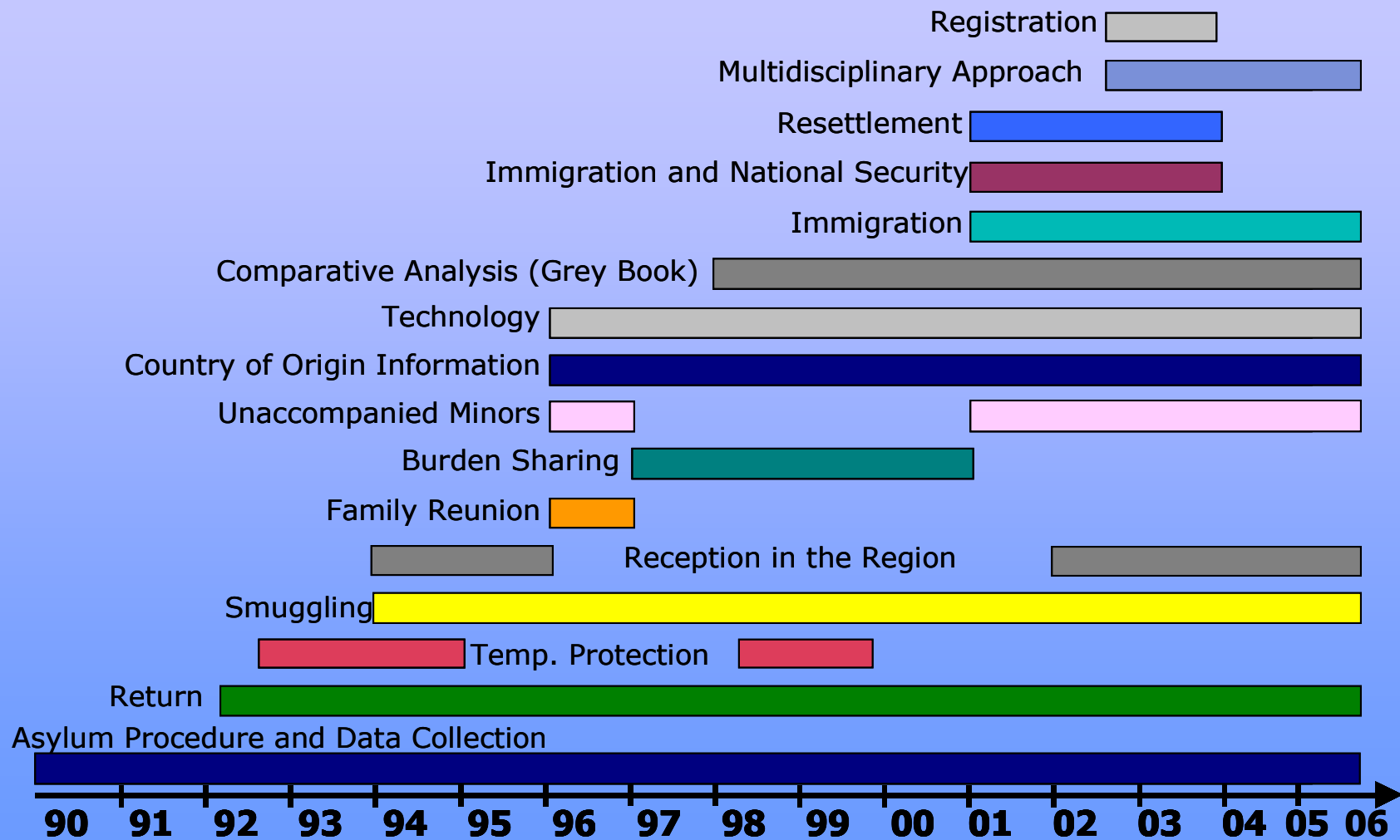
- ✦ Reports to Chair, Troika and Participating States

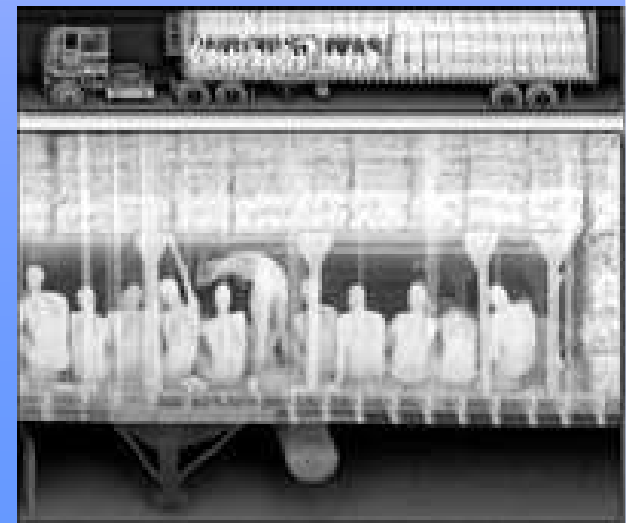

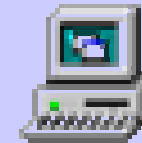
