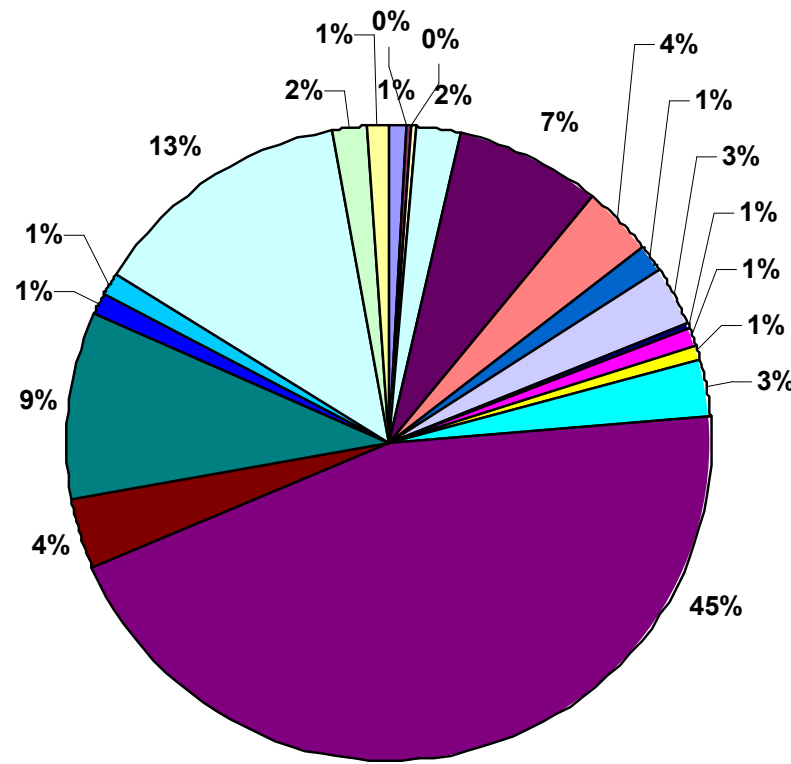


Immigrant Population in Portugal Evolution and Geographical Distribution

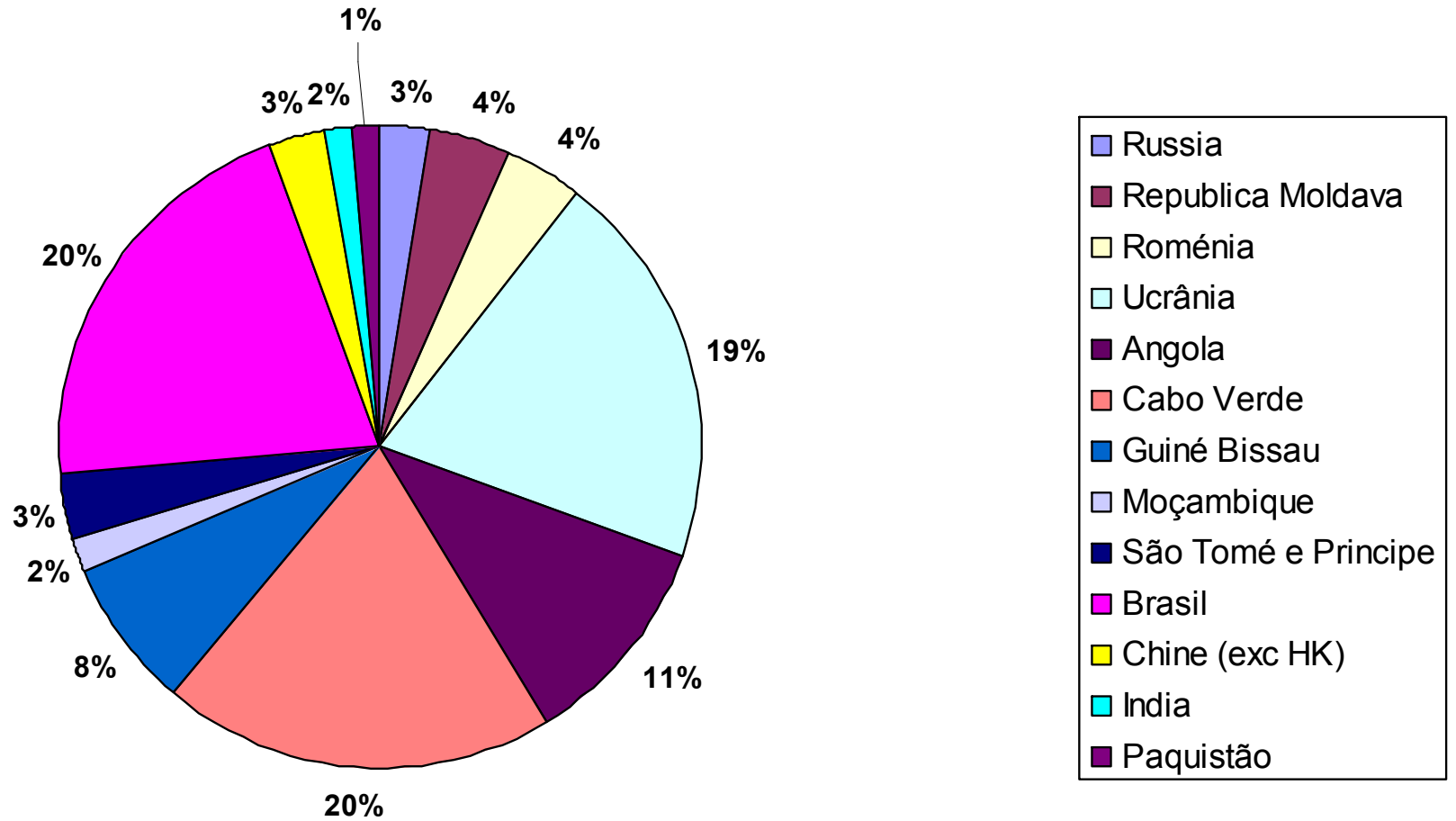
Geographical Distribution (per district)



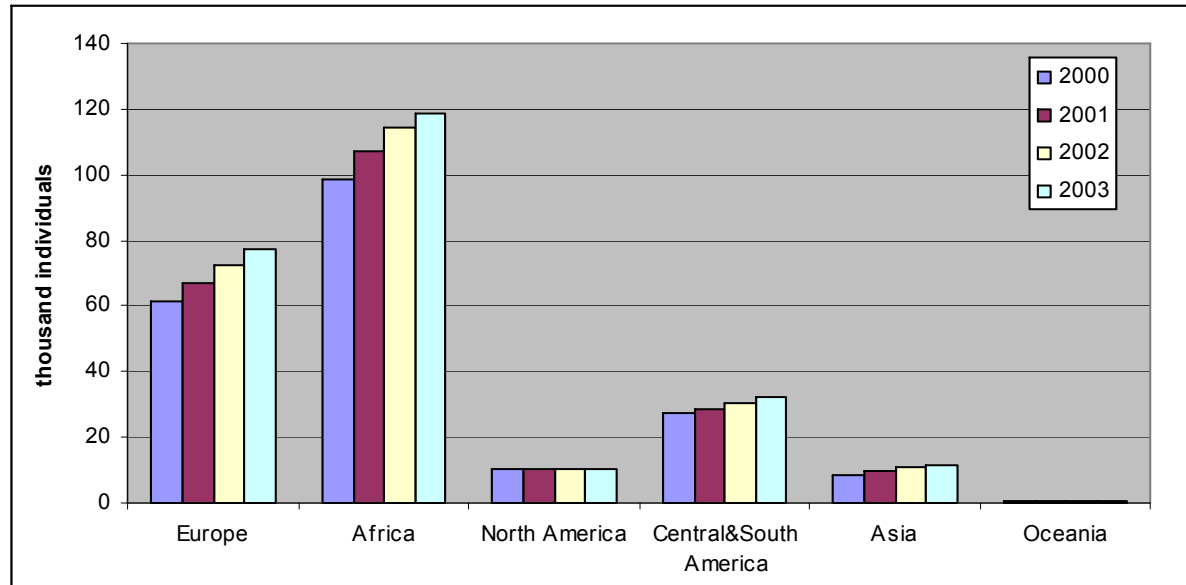

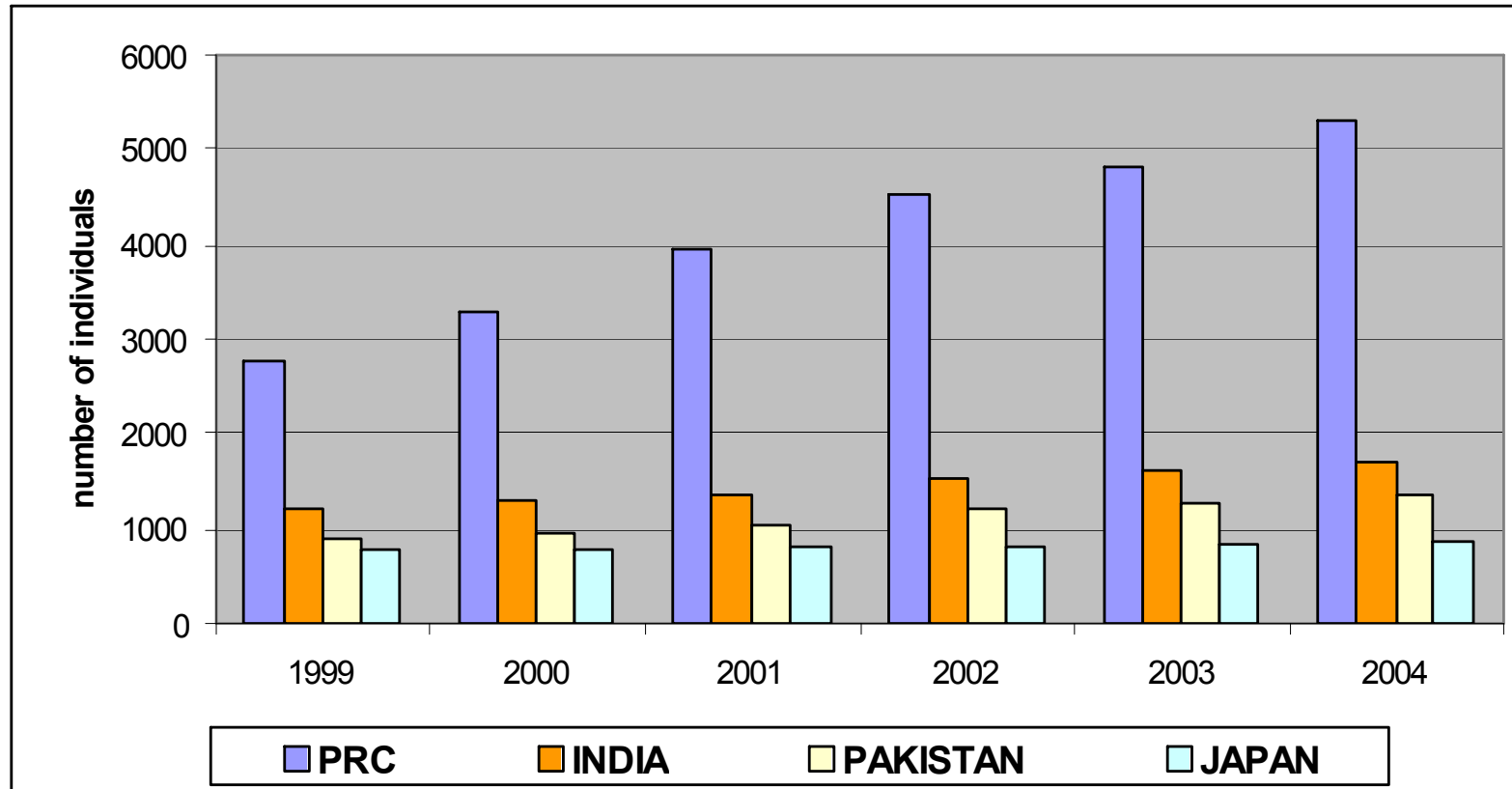
PORTUGAL - Number of immigrants according to geographic origin



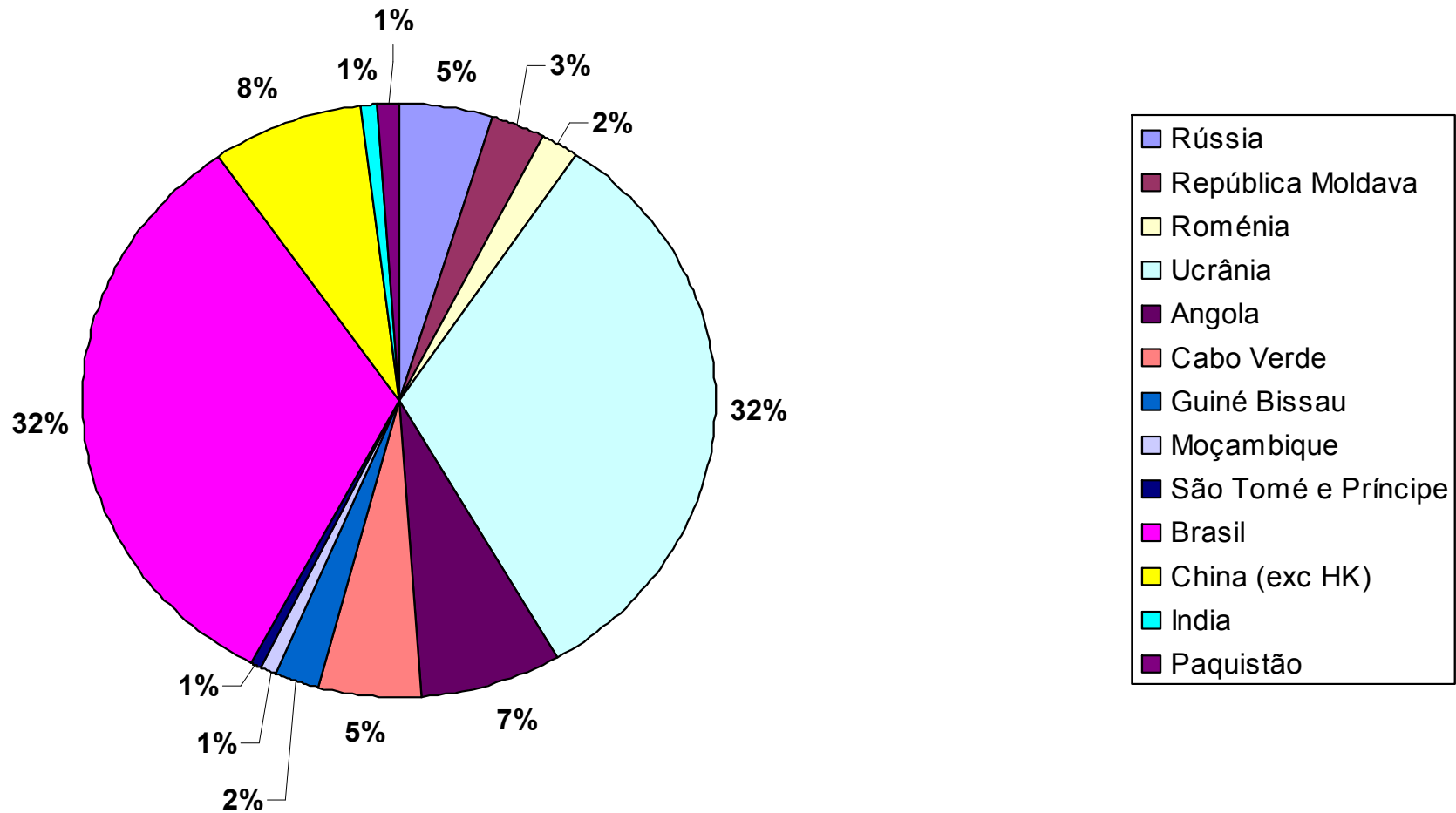

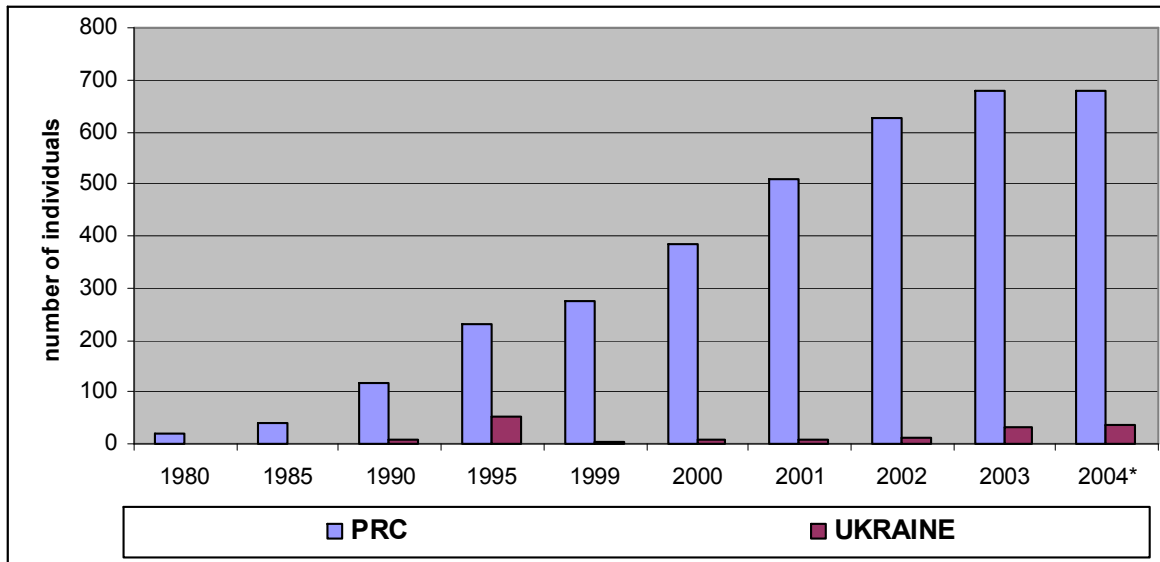
PORTUGAL - Asian immigration – distribution *per* four top nationalities



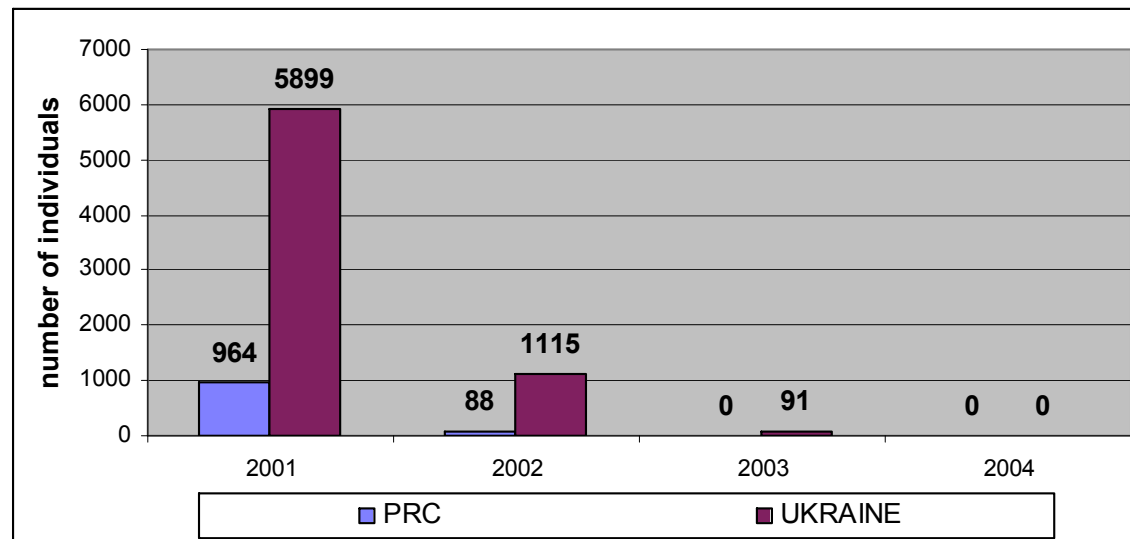
PORTO District: Residency Permit & Permit to Stay (2005)
