Facts & figures

- 16,7 million inhabitants
- 1,7 million non western migrants(2005)
- growth 2,4 million non western migrants (2020)
- 450 out of 11.000 neighbourhoods (25% migrated population)
- 90 neighbourhoods (50% in four big cities)

Facts & figures (Dutch policy)

- high priority in 56 neighbourhoods (urban renewal and sustainable neighbourhoods)
- privatisation (free market) public housing (negative development for low incomes) 40% public housing
- debating cultural diversity in architecture (function and identity in housing and public space)
