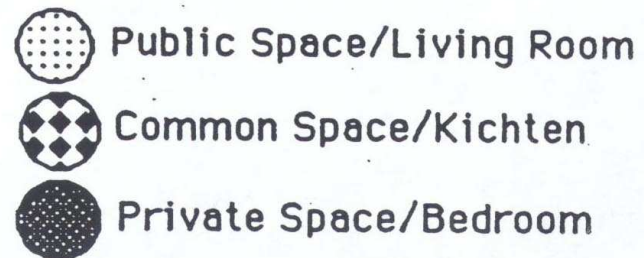
## Diagram of Circulation Patterns of Homes

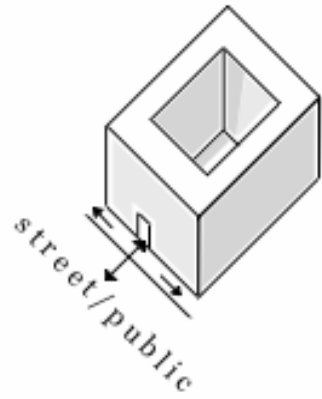

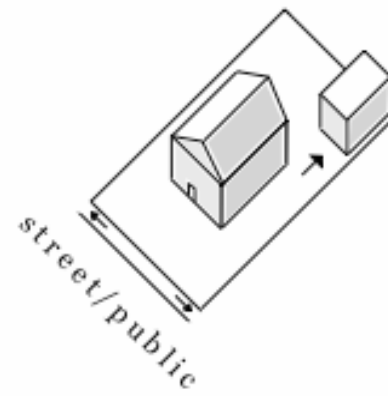

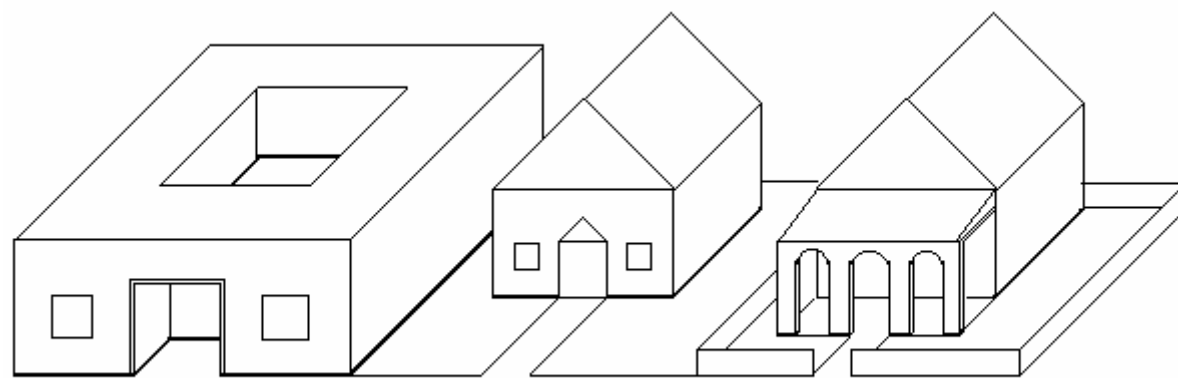
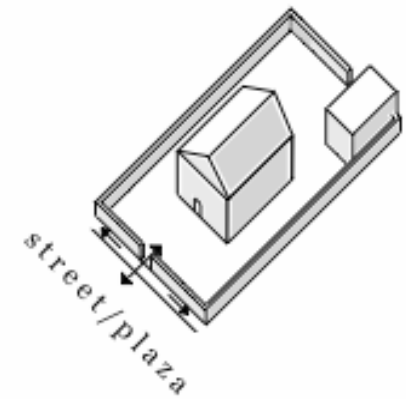
1. Typical courtyard-style building, Mexico; public and private intermingle

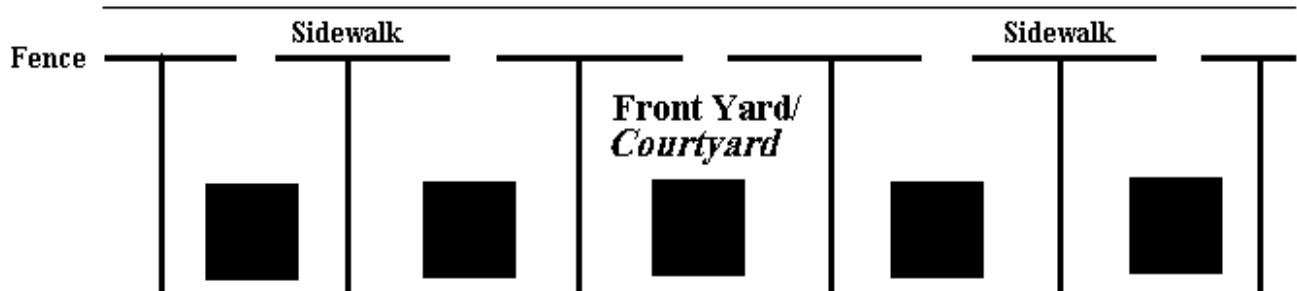
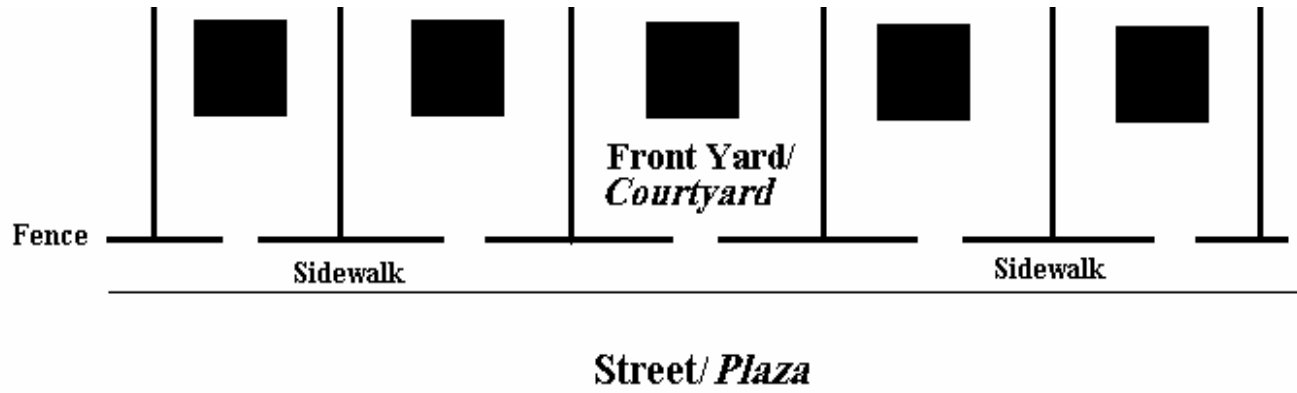
